

Southern Futures & FEVER 2009 Vocational Training Course

General Construction (Bricklaying)

Full Cert 1 in General Construction BCG10103

This course introduces students to the Construction Industry allowing them to experience bricklaying skills. The competencies gained in this course can provide entry into a Prevocational course or an Apprenticeship.

Job Summary: Bricklayers lay bricks, pre-cut stone, concrete and other types of building blocks in mortar to construct and repair walls, foundations, partitions, arches and other structures. They may perform tasks such as working from plans and specifications; seal foundations and damp-resistant materials; spread layers of mortar, & remove excess mortar as well as checking vertical and horizontal alignments; use various tools and brick-cutting machines to cut and shape bricks; construct arches and ornamental brick work; repair & maintain clay bricks; and erect scaffolding.

Desired Attributes:	Need to be physically fit, enjoy practical and outdoor work, be able to work as part of a team, be able to work at a constant pace and be able to follow precise instructions.
Career Pathways	Desire year 12, but min year 10, followed by an apprenticeship in General Construction. Refer to www.myfutures.edu.au for career pathway information
