

Southern Futures & FEVER 2009 Vocational Training Course

Introduction to Hair & Beauty (SIR10107)

** Skill development – not a Certificate course **

This course is designed to give students a taste of the Hairdressing & Beauty industries whilst attending school. They will gain a range of skills and experiences including some hair, manicure, nail art, skin care and make-up. It can assist students gain pre-employment skills for hair, beauty or pharmacy sales employment. Students are required to do 55 hrs of research and homework.

Desired Attributes:	Must have good health with no skin allergies, pleasant personality, good communication skills, be able to work under pressure, have good hand-eye coordination, have patience, possess some creative flair, show attention to detail and be able and willing to follow instructions.
Career Pathways:	Prefer year 12; minimum year 10. Employment via an Apprenticeship. Refer to www.myfutures.edu.au for career pathway information
Location:	Hair & Beauty, Noarlunga Campus, TAFE SA (on the upper level at the eastern end of TAFE ie: the Noarlunga Community Hospital end of TAFE)
Training Provider:	TAFE SA (RTO 40161)
Duration:	1 day per week x 9 weeks, except in Term 4 where is for 8 wks with longer hours. Thursday 12 th February for Term 1; Friday 8 th May for Term 2; Friday 31 st July for Term 3; Thursday? 15 th October for Term 4 2009 Recommend yr 11 & 12 undertake in terms 1 – 3 to have results in time for SSABSA
Times:	9.30 am – 3.30 pm (NB the Term 4 day may be extended to finish earlier)
Approx Cost:	\$581.80 plus \$5 ID (2009)
Work Placement:	5 days work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet
Student Requirements:	Need to bring pencil and paper to each session. Dress; clean black and whites with enclosed shoes suitable for standing for a long time; no thongs or track pants. Students are required to do research and homework. Students must attend every session to qualify for a pass and gain the 100 hours required for 2 SACE units. If absent, the student must phone the Hair & Beauty department on 8207 3919 to inform them of the absence.
