Beauty – “Let’s make-Up”

Part Cert 3 in Beauty (WRB04)

This course is designed to introduce students to the world of make up, with particular emphasis on designing and applying different make-ups for different occasions. It is an excellent insight into what is involved in the make-up and beauty industry. They will also gain knowledge in retail and skin care. On successful completion of this course they will gain credit towards other TAFE courses and SACE.

Desired Attributes:	Must be well groomed at all times, have good health, be pleasant and tactful, have a genuine interest in people, have good hand-eye coordination, and be sensitive when treating clients for body and facial treatments.
Career Pathways:	Prefer year 12; minimum year 10. Employment via an Apprenticeship. Refer to www.myfutures.edu.au for career pathway options.
Location:	Hair & Beauty, Noarlunga Campus, TAFE SA (on the upper level at the eastern end of TAFE ie: the Noarlunga Community Hospital end of TAFE)

Duration:	1 day per week x 9 weeks, term 2 from Friday 8 th May, term 3 from Friday 31 st July or term 4 from Friday 16 th October
Times:	9.30 am – 3.30 pm
Approx Cost:	\$ 586.80 - includes student ID \$5 (2009)
Work Placement:	5 days work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet
Student Requirements:	Students can use a TAFE starter kit or purchase their own for approx \$80. Must bring pens and paper to all sessions. Dress in black and white (no sneakers or track pants) If absent, the student must ring the Hair & Beauty office on 8207 3919 the morning of the absence.
