HOSPITALITY (Liquor Service)

(part of Cert 2 – can count towards Cert 1 Or Cert 2) SIT 20207

This course covers the skills required to work in all types of bars in the Hospitality industry.

Desired attributes:	Possess good interpersonal skills, have a good memory, be efficient and speedy, enjoy working with people, be prepared to work weekends and evenings, possess good cash-handling skills, and be able to stand for long periods.
