Spotlight on a job

C10106/2008 – Trainee Adelaide Convention Centre

Hospitality Trainees will be rotated through seven operational departments during the first 12 months of the program: Event Floor Services, Regattas Bistro, Stewarding, Kitchen, House Services, Set Crew and Customer Relations. At the conclusion of the first year trainees are able to specialise in one or more of the above departments. Trainees will be responsible for providing a range of food and beverage related services within the above departments as they acquire skills from their on and off the job training. Specific duties will range from basic food preparation in the main kitchen to providing table service of various meals and a range of beverages in a wide range of events. Other duties will include cleaning dishwashing, furniture/equipment moving and front office clerical tasks. Trainees will undertake studies in the Certificate 3 in Hospitality as part of the traineeship which is delivered by the Adelaide Convention centre under its Registered Training Organisation capabilities.

C10104/2008 – Apprentice Adelaide Convention Centre

Apprentices are rotated through four district areas within the Centre's Kitchens Cold Larder, Pastry, Hot Kitchen, Regattas Bistro (A La Carte Kitchen). Our cookery apprenticeships are at the Certificate 3 level and have a duration of four years. Training 'off the job' is provided by the Regency Campus of TAFE SA North however about 80% of your time will be spent in training on the job at the Adelaide Convention Centre in the above mentioned sections. Besides cookery related duties, apprentices undertake basic cleaning and stewarding duties to acquaint themselves with all aspects of a large commercial kitchen,
