

Community Partnerships @ Work 2011 Vocational Training Course

Beauty - Acrylic Nails (Top Up) Part Certificate 2 Nail Technician (WRB04)

This course is delivered using a combination of tutorial and practical workshops in a fully simulated salon, supported by structured workplace learning in partnership with leading hairdressing salons. The course meets current industry requirements & develops student's skills & knowledge as a salon assistant. This is a step towards an apprenticeship as a beautician.

Desired Attributes:	Must have good health with no skin allergies, pleasant personality, good communication skills, be able to work under pressure, have good hand-eye coordination, have patience, possess some creative flair, show attention to detail and be able and willing to follow instructions.
Career Pathways:	Prefer year 12; minimum year 10. Employment via an Apprenticeship. Refer to www.myfutures.edu.au for career pathway information Beauty – The Makeup & Beauty Palette (9 weeks) or Acrylic Nails (9 wks) ⇔ The Makeup Journey (30 weeks – Cert 2)
Location:	Hair & Beauty, Noarlunga Campus, TAFE SA (on the upper level at the eastern end of TAFE ie: the Noarlunga Community Hospital end of TAFE)
Training Provider:	TAFESA South (RTO 40319)
Duration:	1 day per week x 10 weeks (Wednesday). Term 2 Wednesday 11 th May – July 6 th , Term 3: Wednesday 28 th July – 22 nd September, depending on nos.
Times:	9.30 am – 4.00 pm
Approx Cost:	RTO fee = \$615.50 (inclds ID) {2011} + kit \$180 Brokerage fee = \$110 (incl GST) Total fee = \$725.50 (not including kit) NB kit needed at start of course,
Work Placement:	We recommend 5 days work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet to back up this course.
Student Requirements:	Year 11 or 12 students only. Bring pencil and paper to each session. Dress: clean black and whites with enclosed shoes suitable for standing for a long time; no thongs or track pants. Students are required to do research and homework. Regular attendance is expected. If absent, the student must phone the Hair & Beauty department on 8207 3919 to inform them of the absence.
