Part Cert 2 in Makeup Services (WRB20204)

This course is designed to extend student knowledge of the world of make up, with particular emphasis on designing and applying different make-ups for different occasions. It is an excellent insight into what is involved in the make-up and beauty industry. Students will gain knowledge of makeup, skin care, grooming of hands & nails and facials.
