

Directions in Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy (Nat Code NYS40625SA)

** Part Cert 2 in Education & Skills Development (40625SA) **

This course is designed to give students an **introduction** to the Hairdressing & Beauty industries whilst attending school. They will gain a range of skills and experiences including braiding & shampooing hair, skin care & manicuring, styling and personal presentation. Students will explore career opportunities within and beyond Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy. The course can assist students gain pre-employment skills for hair, beauty or pharmacy sales employment. Students are required to do 55 hrs of research and homework.

Desired Attributes:	Must have good health with no skin allergies, pleasant personality, good communication skills, be able to work under pressure, have good hand-eye coordination, have patience, possess some creative flair, show attention to detail and be able and willing to follow instructions.
Career Pathways:	Prefer year 12; minimum year 10. Employment via an Apprenticeship. Duration:	1 day per week x 9 weeks (Thursdays – NB may run Wednesdays if nos. are low) Term 1: Thursday 9 th February; Term 2: Thursday 3 rd May; Term 3: Thursday 26 th Jul; Term 4 (modified course): Thursday October 18 th (5 weeks – cheaper price) Recommend yr 11 & 12 undertake in terms 1 – 3 to have results in time for SSABSA

Work Placement:	We recommend 5 days work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet to compliment this course.
Student Requirements:	Students need to bring pencil and paper to each session, and are required to do research and homework. Dress: clean black and whites with enclosed shoes suitable for standing for a long time; no thongs or track pants. Students must attend every session to quality for a pass and gain the 90 hours. If absent, the student must phone the Hair & Beauty department on 8207 3919 to inform them of the absence.
