

**Pathway to Cert 3 in Hairdressing ( WRH30109)**

**\*\* Part Certificate 3 in Hairdressing \*\***

*This course is designed to extend student knowledge and skills in the Hairdressing industry whilst attending school. They will gain knowledge & skills in retailing, hair design & hair science. It is a hands on program including projects, tutorials & practical workshops.*

<b>Desired Attributes:</b>	Must have good health with no skin allergies, pleasant personality, good communication skills, be able to work under pressure, have good hand-eye coordination, have patience, possess some creative flair, show attention to detail and be able and willing to follow instructions.
<b>Career Pathways:</b>	Prefer year 12; minimum year 10. Employment via an Apprenticeship. Refer to <a href="http://www.myfutures.edu.au">www.myfutures.edu.au</a> for career pathway information  <b>Hair</b> - Directions in Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy (9 weeks) ⇒ The Hair Focus ( 9 weeks) ⇔ or ⇔ Hairdressing Cert 2 (32 weeks – Cert 2) ⇒ Pathway to Cert 3 Hairdressing (25 wks) <b>Beauty</b> – The Makeup & Beauty Palette (9 weeks) ⇒ Cert 2 Retail Make Up (30 weeks – Cert 2)
<b>Location:</b>	Hair & Beauty, Noarlunga Campus, TAFE SA South (on the upper level at the eastern end of TAFE ie: near the Noarlunga Community Hospital end of TAFE)
<b>Training Provider:</b>	TAFE SA (RTO 40319)
<b>Duration:</b>	1 day per week x 25weeks. (Thursday) <b>Term 1:</b> Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> February - 6 <sup>th</sup> Sep
<b>Times:</b>	9.30 am – 3.30 pm (NB the Term 4 day may be extended to finish earlier)
<b>Approx Cost:</b>	RTO fee = \$1168.30 (inclds ID + \$95 kit) (2011) Brokerage fee = \$110 ( inclds GST) <b>Total fee = \$1278.30</b>
<b>Work Placement:</b>	Work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet is a compulsory aspect of this course.
<b>Student Requirements:</b>	Need to bring pencil and paper to each session. Dress: clean black and whites with enclosed shoes suitable for standing for a long time; no thongs or track pants. Students are required to do research and homework. Students must attend every session to qualify for a pass and gain the 70 hours. If absent, the student must phone the Hair & Beauty department on 8207 3919 to inform them of the absence.
