** Part Certificate 2 in Education & Skills Development (40625SA) **

This course is designed to extend student knowledge and skills in the Hairdressing industry whilst attending school. They will gain a range of skills including blow drying, shampooing, reception duties, personal image & presentation, and life skills. Applicants must have passed Directions in Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy before enrolling in this course.

Desired Attributes:	Must have good health with no skin allergies, pleasant personality, good communication skills, be able to work under pressure, have good hand-eye coordination, have patience, possess some creative flair, show attention to detail and be able and willing to follow instructions.

Work Placement:	We recommend 5 days work placement in a hair or beauty salon, or chemist, or retail outlet to compliment this course.
Student Requirements:	Need to bring pencil and paper to each session. Dress: clean black and whites with enclosed shoes suitable for standing for a long time; no thongs or track pants. Students are required to do research and homework. Students must attend every session to quality for a pass and gain the 70 hours. If absent, the student must phone the Hair & Beauty department on 8207 3919 to inform them of the absence.
