Part of Cert 2 in Sport (Coaching) SRS20306

This course delivers nationally recognised qualifications in Sport Coaching specialising on Martial Arts to deliver a skill set including sport and exercise science, strength and conditioning, diet & nutrition, coaching principles, risk management, OH&S, emergency response, martial arts theory & practical martial arts development. Improving confidence, attitude, self esteem, self respect, community values & self discipline. It is a non contact sport.

Desired attributes:	Have a good level of physical fitness, possess an enthusiastic, outgoing personality with good communication skills, and having a background in fitness activities may be an advantage. Have basic literacy and numeracy skills.
Career Pathways:	Year 10 minimum, but year 12 preferred. Leads into Fitness & Coaching streams Cert 3 & Diploma. Refer to www.myfutures.edu.au for further career pathway information. Follow-on 10 week sessions are possible after completing this course that provides basics for a pathway in sport, recreation, adventure tourism, fitness, health organisation & management disciplines.
