

### Nursing Pathways (Aged Care) Stage Two

The Pathways to Nursing VET program has become widely recognised as a practical response to skills shortages in Health, attracting young people into the aged care industry, and providing career & education pathways. It is a partnership between the Department of Health, TAFE SA and the Department of Education & Children's Services.

The full **Certificate 3 in Aged Care Work (CHC30102)** is offered over two years of study and allows students to complete subjects related to Aged Care work and gain practical skills in residential aged care facilities.

<b>Desired attributes:</b>	Students should have a genuine interest in following a career within the nursing industry. Stage 2 follows on from Stage 1.

This course leads directly to employment in Aged Care, as well as providing insight into nursing and is a sound platform for those who wish to undertake Enrolled Nursing through TAFE or Registered Nursing through university. Also leads to Cert 4 in Pathology Collection

<b>Work Placement:</b>	<b>A minimum of 140 hours (15shifts) on the job training occurs at the Health Service and/or aged care facility where the students are placed. This occurs as 5 days in a field placement over 2 weeks in each term. Student Log Books are used to record progress in the workplace.</b>
<b>Student requirements:</b>	⇒ Bring paper, pens, pencils, eraser. ⇒ A navy top (eg bonds collared shirt) with Navy/black trousers ( no jeans), and closed in leather shoes (not sneakers) for work placement. ⇒ If ill, it is expected that the student will phone the Noarlunga Campus on 8207 3968 or Mt Barker Campus on 8391 7333 on the morning of the absence. <b>If over 18yo, a police check will be required prior to undertaking work placement</b>
