

HOSPITALITY (Attend Gaming Machines)

(part of Cert 2 or 3 Hospitality) SIT 20207 or 30707

This course will provide students, with skills & knowledge desired by employers for work in gaming rooms. Eg cash clearance of machine, refilling hoppers, clearing jammed coins, replacing light globes in machines, issuing and redeeming tokens, and paying out winnings.
