This course develops the skills and knowledge for a student to be able to function as a qualified driver of a Light Vehicle as used by the trades, deliver industry and taxis.

Desired Attributes:	Confident, keen desire to gain an apprenticeship or to work in an industry where driving is an integral part of the job.

Duration:	1hrs /week (theory component) + 1.5 hrs / wk (driving component) for 18 weeks starting Mon May 2 nd to Mon 5 th September (including school holidays) + 2 hrs /week practical driving with QSD
Times:	1 hr information session to commit and complete paper work Group B – 10.30 – 11.30 (theory), 12 – 1.30 (driving instruction) each Mon from May 2 nd – 5 th September Group C - 2.5pm Monday 2 nd May & then 10.30 – 1.30pm as for Group B

Work Placement:	2 hrs practical driving with a QSD above the training 1.5 hrs is a weekly requirement of this course
Student /QSD Requirements:	Participants will be closely screened & will need to meet the following requirements:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Min 17 yr old • Must have passed Ls and hold an active permit • Must be studying for/or working towards a job or position • Must have a Qualified Supervising Driver who can commit to 2 hrs practical driving experience per week (75 hrs in total over the 18 wks). This person will work through the log book process, and complete the 30 tasks. NB QSD is a parent, guardian, driving instructor who holds a full licence, and has no restrictions on the licence in the past 2 years. • Participants must carry their L permit to all classes and all driving sessions If successful:- Need to bring pencil and paper to each theory session. Dress; neat casual with closed in footwear. Students must phone absences to the CP@W office on 8186 7200 the morning of the absence. NB if absent for sessions catch up will cost \$100/1.5 hr
