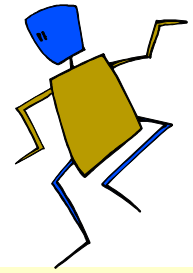


"On the Move"

On the Move is a learning transition program providing participants with information on the expectations of the workforce and to help them determine, prepare and successfully enter post-secondary employment or further education and/or training.

We are looking for young people who are

- FLO enrolled
- Over the age of compulsion
- Willing to be supported with a training/ employment pathway.

Focus will also be placed on enhancing knowledge of life skills associated with work and independence.

Each participant will continue with their current FLO case manager and will also access additional support from the On the Move Coordinator to assist with;

- Ongoing 'One to One' coaching
- Life skills and employability skills training
- Career development, support, advice & action planning
- Personal development & access to 'Duke of Edinburgh Award'
- Vocational Training via TAFE, VET short courses, literacy/numeracy
- Assistance to achieve SACE accreditation (where applicable)
- Assistance with Job Search & referrals
- Work Experience
