

# Southern Futures & FEVER 2009 Vocational Training Course

## Introduction to Trades – Vocational Preparation

Part of Certificate 1 & 2 Conservation & Land Management (RTD02), Community Services (CHC02), and Metal & Engineering (MEM05), and IVEC units

*This is a pre-apprenticeship programme which will prepare students for work or further study in the engineering, mechanics, building or prefabrication trade areas. It has a strong emphasis on improving the literacy and numeracy skills as required by industry. Students who apply for post school TAFE courses will gain extra credit for having successfully completed this course. Parents and students need to be aware that this is a 'general access' course, and may have non-secondary students in it.*

<b>Desired attributes:</b>	Students need to enjoy practical and manual work, be physically fit, have good eyesight & good hand-eye coordination, be able to carry out repetitive tasks quickly and methodically, be able to work as part of a team, be able to read instructions and be safety conscious. Year 11 or 12 students preferred

<b>Training Provider:</b>	TAFESA (RTO 40161)
<b>Duration:</b>	2 days ( Monday & Friday) /wk for 5 weeks T1 Mon 23 <sup>rd</sup> Feb – Mon 30 <sup>th</sup> Mar, T2 Mon 11 <sup>th</sup> May – Fri 12 <sup>th</sup> Jun, T3 Mon 10 <sup>th</sup> Aug – Fri 4 <sup>th</sup> Sep.
<b>Times:</b>	9.00am – 4.00pm ( lunch 12.00 – 12.45pm)
<b>Cost:</b>	\$122.45 + white card \$65.00 + \$5 ID = \$192.45 (2009 price)
<b>Work Placement:</b>	Undertaking a 5 – 10 day work placement in industry would complement the course and provide employer contact which could increase apprenticeship opportunities
